### COVID 19 safety

As a school we are constantly reviewing our safety measures. Last half-term when the weather was warmer it was easy to have windows and doors open to allow ventilation throughout the buildings. Now even though the weather is colder, we still need to ensure rooms are adequately ventilated. This means at times throughout the day windows and doors will need to be opened and so the rooms may be colder than usual. With this in mind your child may need to wear some additional layers underneath their school uniform.

As we have now entered a period of increased COVID 19 restrictions, it seems prudent to review the use of face coverings on the school site at drop off and collection times. I would respectfully ask that from Monday 9<sup>th</sup> November all adults dropping off and collecting children wear an appropriate face covering whilst on the school site. However, we recognise that some in our school community may be exempt from wearing a mask and if that is the case we do not expect you to wear one.

May we please also remind you that only one adult per family should be coming onto school site for drop off and collection. When exiting school, parents and carers are also reminded to use the footpath alongside the car park. The car park can be very busy at times with deliveries.
