Summer Holiday Topic Homework

Dear Families,

We all enjoyed a successful transfer morning in Pegasus Class and we are very much looking forward to working with the children from September.

I have already begun planning for next term; it will be action packed and full of surprises! I will write to you again in September to tell you about our routines and expectations including maths, spelling, and reading homework.

Our first topic is 'Me and My Community'. This topic will support the children with settling into new rules and routines of school and encourages them to make friends and feel confident in the class. The children will learn about being helpful, kind and thoughtful at home and at school. They will also think about how they are unique and special, the importance of friendship and how people in their family, school and local community are important and can help them.

We have created a Topic Overview to give you a taster of everything we will be covering next term, including how you can help your child at home. This overview is also available on the school website.

In preparation for our topic, we would like both Nursery and Reception children to complete a piece of good quality topic homework which needs to be brought into school on the first day back – Tuesday 2nd September. Each child is encouraged to share and discuss their work with a group of peers before we incorporate it into a topic display.

Topic Homework

There are lots of people in our community who help us. Talk about how these people help us. Choose one of the people and make a thank you card for them.

OR

Build a model of your house or other favourite place in the community such as a park, friends house, particular shop etc.

Please encourage your child to share stories with you every day as this really helps with their language and literacy development. Also, don't forget the importance of looking for opportunities to develop maths knowledge – whether it is counting sweets, hunting shapes or playing board games.
