As part of the topic, we would also be keen to hear from anybody who used to attend Hailey Primary School, so if you have any family members who would be willing to come in and talk to the children about their experiences, it would be much appreciated. Please do send me a message on Dojo, if this is something you would be able to help with.

Please also try and read with and to your child everyday as this really helps with their language and literacy development. Where possible, look for opportunities to encourage writing; children could even keep a holiday diary which they could bring in to show me in September. Also think about ways you can consolidate maths knowledge – whether it is counting how many peas are on their plate at dinner time or practicing the skills of addition and subtraction with the amount of money that has been spent on holiday!

We have already begun planning for next term which will be action packed and full of surprises! We will write to you again in September to remind you of routines and expectations including maths, spelling, and reading homework.
