Message from the Buckinghamshire, Oxfordshire and Berkshire West Integrated Care Board (BOB ICB) Get your child aged five to 11 vaccinated against COVID-19 during the half term school holiday

You can get your child aged five to 11 vaccinated against COVID-19 during the half term school holiday.

This includes children aged five and over (who turned five on or before 31 August 2022) who will be offered first and second paediatric (child) doses of the vaccine, with at least 12 weeks between doses. Children who turned five on or after 1 September 2022 can only get a first and second dose of the vaccine if they are either:

- At high risk due to a health condition or because of a weakened immune system
- Living with someone who has a weakened immune system
