News from the Governing Body

On Wednesday this week, the full governing board came back together for their first meeting of the new year. We hope all of our families had both a restful and enjoyable break.

We focused on the school budget, which concluded with us having to deliver our financial assessment and internal audit. The purpose of this is to help schools meet standards of good financial health and resource management, as well allowing us to put challenging questions to the local authority. Last term, we highlighted the financial restraints placed on schools and the resources available to them, and this continues to be a real area of concern. We also received a presentation from the Headteacher that outlined the school's self-evaluation. This allowed us to identify, through statements of measure, the performance of the school. This led us onto reflecting upon the Autumn term data in comparison to national averages and those pupils performing at greater depth. This was both valuable and extremely encouraging to read.

During the meeting, governors also reflected on policies related to SEND and medical conditions in school. We also ensured that as a board we are ready for our impending safeguarding audit and as governors we continue to maintain up to date knowledge of safeguarding and guidance related to keeping children safe in education.

Please do remember, we are looking for new governors, and currently have a parent vacancy. Additionally, we also have positions for members of our community with different skills that would complement the board and school. If you think this might be something you can offer, then please do not hesitate to get in contact if you would like to make a difference to the school.
