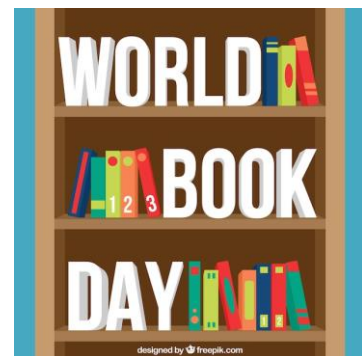


Empty Bottles Please

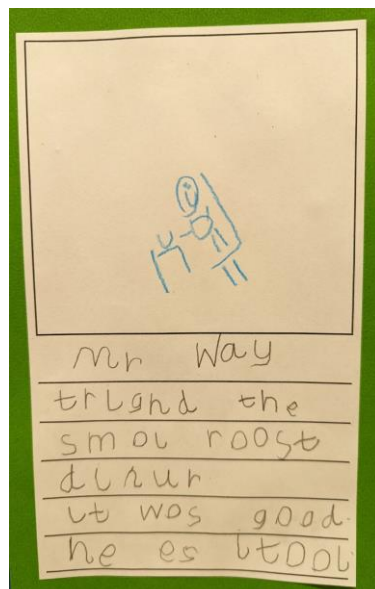
