Please use the reading diaries to record the book to record the book your child is reading and make relevant comments with regards to how you feel your child is getting on with the book or any words they have found challenging. Please also feel free to share books from home, these will count too. For nursery children, you are welcome to comment on how your child responded to the book; did they enjoy it? Can they retell the story?
