Governing Body Response to Questionnaires

At the Full Governing Body meeting on Wednesday 31st January 2024 the governors discussed the results of our parent questionnaire.

For the parent questionnaires there was an approximate return rate of 50%. It was noted that this is a high return rate. There were several positives observed by the Governing Body, for example 98% of parents said their child was happy at the school, 95% of parents felt the school makes sure its pupils are well behaved, no parents felt their child was not safe at the school and 93% of parents said their child does well at the school with couple of respondents not sure.

One area from the survey the school would like to explore further is our after-school provision. There is a club every day open to all pupils that offers a wide range of activities however, it does not specifically have one focus such as karate or art and craft on a Friday. Mrs Davies is keen to widen that offer and create some more specific clubs where we have staffing to do so. There will be more to follow in upcoming newsletters.

The Governors would like to thank everyone who replied to the questionnaire. School staff are keen to promote the open-door policy. Staff are always happy to meet parents and Mrs Davies is in school every day if you would like to speak to her.

Payments for School Meals

Please may we remind you to ensure your child's account in ParentPay for school meals is in credit before your child orders a meal. Several parent accounts are in debt each week and administration time is being spent having to contact parents for payments. Credit can be added in advance and remain in your account until a meal is ordered.
