We have received information from the Education Safeguarding Advisory Team at OCC about an online WhatsApp group where pupils have been added by friends without their permission. The aim of the group is to try and become the biggest WhatsApp group in the UK which they believe was called 'Everybody in the UK' but may also have been called 'Ronaldo'. There are concerns that messages in this group are disturbing. Please be aware that the age guidance for WhatsApp according to the NSPCC website is 16+ years old but if your child does use it then we would urge you to check your child's online activity.
