Discover amazing information about the world around us with the help of LEGO minifigures and bricks and building challenges along the way.

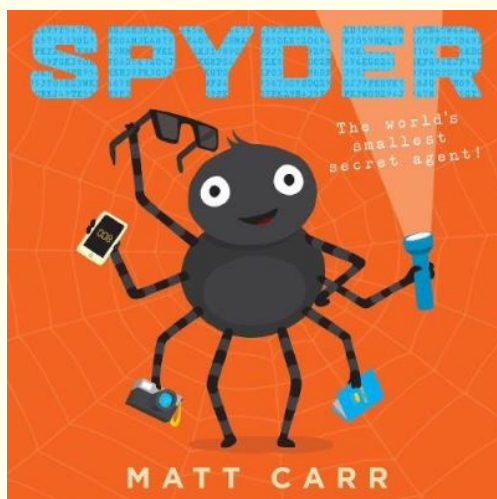


Recommended Reads

Can they find the answer before it's too late?

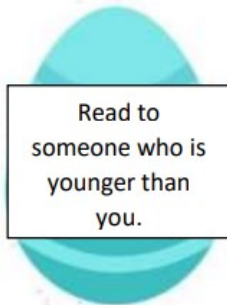

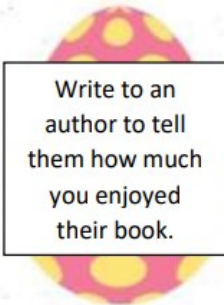
Read to someone who is younger than you.



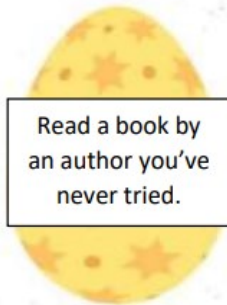
Read a book all the way from the start to end!



Visit the library and borrow a book.



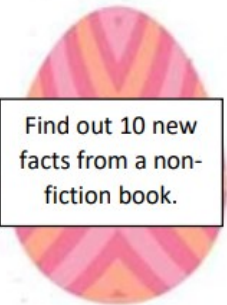

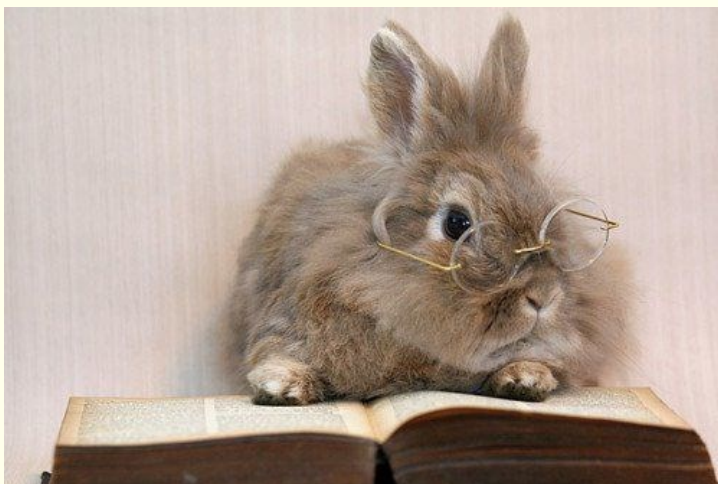
